Appellation: AOC wine from Savoy.

Terroir:

Clay-limestone soil, stony scree-slopes, sunny hillside, orientation: south / south-east facing the Great Alps.

Grape Variety:

100% Mondeuse. Ancient varieties of Savoy that gave birth to Syrah.

Management of the vineyard:

Sustainable agriculture: grass growing between rows, mechanical weeding under the rows, reasonable level of treatment for the vines in accordance with the risks of diseases.

Vinification / maturing:

Hand-picking, partial de-stemming for the maceration: 50 % of the bunches of grapes. Maceration lasts for two weeks under controlled temperature. Maturation: 6 months in vats.

Tasting:

Beautiful reddish purple color with violet steaks.

The nose: little red berries and spring flowers (violets), real pepper notes.

The wine is round in the mouth, it has a nice freshness and the final reveals the tannins that gives it a nice length.

Service:

Enjoy it now preferably 15-16°C. Can be stored 2 or 3 years.

Gastronomy:

Pork meat (charcuterie) or leg of lamb. Perfect with cheese.
