Appellation: AOC wine from Savoy.

Terroir:

This Mondeuse is products with selected parcel from the vineyard. The soil there consists of glacial clay-limestone. Orientation: south / south-east facing the Great Alps.

Grape Variety:

100% Mondeuse. Old traditional grape from Savoy.

Vineyard Management:

Sustainable agriculture: grass growing between rows, mechanical weeding under the rows, reasonable level of treatment for the vines in accordance with the risks of diseases.

Winemaking / maturing:

Hand-picking, vatting with gravity (without pump). Maceration with whole crop, lasts for two weeks under controlled temperature. Maturation: 6 months in vats.

Tasting:

Beautiful ruby hue with plum hints. Nice nose with aroma of ripe black fruit and flowers, slightly spicy and some mint notes. In the mouth, the soft structure is characterized by the finesse and elegance of the tannins.

Service:

Enjoy it preferably at 15-16°C. This Mondeuse can be enjoyed young, or be conserved 4-5 years.

Gastronomy:

Roast red meat. Chocolate cakes.
